Our goal is to build relationships with our young members, while educating them on the services we provide as a Credit Union. In 2021 we launched our redesigned youth savings and rewards program, The Wilderness Savings Club! This forest-themed program was established to provide our youth members with the necessary tools to help make saving exciting, while earning rewards.

Our Wilderness Savings Club branches into four groups that focus on ageappropriate goals to help establish positive financial habits: Ages 0-4 Sprout Savers, Ages 5-9 Forest Friends, Ages 10-13 Eagle Earners, Ages 14-18 Park Rangers.

Our Forest Friends, Eagle Earners and Park Rangers earn rewards for every deposit made to their savings account which can be redeemed for gift cards to favorite places, such as Amazon, Target, Starbucks, Panera, Dave & Busters, and many more. Forest Friends and Eagle Earner aged members will earn Buford Bucks which they can redeem for their prize, with prize levels starting at as little as 5 Buford Bucks! For Park Rangers, each \$20 deposit will earn them a spot on their membership card. With ten spots filled on their card, they will earn a \$25 gift card.

SMALL BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT

As "Your Community Credit Union", NCFCU would like to showcase other small businesses in our community. For this issue, our spotlight shines on a local non-profit group, Friends of the West Shore Theatre, founded in 2018. Governed by a Board of Directors comprised of members of the local community, this organization set out with a mission to determine the future of a historic landmark in New Cumberland, located at 317 Bridge Street. For those of you that grew up in our community, you can remember the nostalgia of the West Shore Theatre, established in 1939. With the goal of preserving



the future of this theatre, the motto of the Friends of the West Shore Theatre is "Restore, Revitalize, Reinvent."

During its heyday, the West Shore Theatre was a social gathering place featuring movies of the period before television became a staple in the household. Of the twelve local theatres of this style, the West Shore Theatre is the only one that still remains. For this new revitalized theatre's plan, the vision is to "bring back the memories and create new ones". Live events will be added to the traditional classic movie schedule, including live jazz, bluegrass, blues, folk and traditional music singers/song writers, touring artists and local performers with potential acts from community music groups, small plays or stand-up comics.

Redevelopment of the West Shore Theatre is to be completed by Chris Dawson Architect (CDA) an award-winning architect and contemporary design firm. Their plans include transforming the theatre back to its original glory, with the addition of a modern thrust stage to incorporate the "live" show addition, new concession/reception area with high top tables, and a restored auditorium featured booth and table style seating framing the perimeter. Construction on this historic theatre is already underway.

"The community is at the core of our vision for the theatre, and we are excited for its future— not only as a theatre, but as a venue for live performances, special events, private parties, and so much more," said Gennifer Richie, Board of Directors, Friends of the West Shore Theatre. "General construction and renovations have begun and our capital campaign is well underway, but plenty of opportunities remain for anyone interested in being part of this historic revitalization and rebirth that will impact our community for decades to come."
